



Language Interpretation



Previous Topics Covered

- **Economic Support:** “A parent can’t focus on a child’s development when rent is due.”
- **Maternal and Child Health:** “Systemic gaps in maternal health don’t just harm parents. They fracture early childhood.”
- **Developmental Environments:** “Cool, shaded spaces in the summer aren’t luxuries. They’re foundations for development.”
- **Homelessness** “When families are homeless, the child’s first classroom is chaos.”
- **Housing Stability** “Without stable housing, early childhood becomes survival, not growth.”
- **Family Support** “Families shouldn’t be met with referrals; they should be met with presence, dignity, and real, tangible warm hand-offs to services they need.”
- **Nutrition** “You can’t fuel a child’s mind on an empty stomach.”
